U.S.G.A. RULES

GOVERN PLAY LOCAL RULES

Out of bounds markers will be found on holes 1 , $2,12,16,17$ and 18 .

No. 2, 4, 6 and 10 ponds are considered yellow penalty areas.

No. 5, 7, 12 and 15 ponds are considered red penalty areas.

No. 10 and 16 brooks will be considered lateral water hazards.

## LOCAL RULES

1. Proper golf attire must be worn at all times.
2. Players are expected to use cart paths and to obey all posted signs.
3. Each player must have his/her own set of clubs.
4. Players are encouraged to use the alternative to stroke and distance for a lost ball or out of bounds. Drop in the nearest fairway reference point for a penalty of two-strokes. 5. Starters and rangers shall have the right to pair up players. 6. Players having a hole open ahead must, upon request, pick up and move to the next hole.
5. Rain checks will be issued only if the course is closed due to inclement weather or dangerous conditions.

Players not following rules will be asked to leave without a refund.
Irrigation water is not potable.
Raceway Golf Club will not be responsible for injury to person or damage to property of any player or other person on the golf course. The golfer is responsible for the flight of his/her golf ball. No alcoholic beverages are allowed to be brought onto the golf course property.
